
What is a Partnership Evening?

Progression through school runs through fine - though blink and you miss it - but we are now heading to the business end of things...


You are now pretty much half-way through... Almost closer to the end than the beginning...


Meeting Some Dreams & Some Realities...

How do you know your child is going to be heading off in the right direction?




Comfort 1 - DfE Performance Tables

Last week the DfE Performance Tables came out...

Our school was the best performing school in Staffordshire - same as 2022 and 2019...

We do not get everything right - you will know that - but we get a lot right and that should be some comfort...

And we have used the Performance Tables to work out what we need to get better on...



Comfort 2 - Target Grades

These grades are a great guide to you in terms of where your child is heading...

They are based on the expectations the government have of your child...

They stem from the Y6 SATs results (or in your case CATs) your child got and say what your child should (statistically) get by the end of Year 11.

It is vital you understand what these mean for your child - that you understand their trajectory...

What are the Grades for the Next Steps?

A-Levels:

You need at least a 6 to go on to do an A-Level.

A 6 would suggest a C/D at A-Level.

Universities now have to look at GCSEs.

Level 3 Vocational in Sixth Form:

You need at least a 5 / Pass to go on to do a 'Sixth Form Vocational.

Level 3 Vocational in College:

You would need at least a 4 in English & Maths - plus three other subjects.

Higher Level Apprenticeship:

You usually would need to have done Sixth Form and grades will be checked.

Lower Level Apprenticeship:

You would need at least a 4 in English & Maths.

Entry / Level 1 / Level 2 College Course:

You would need at least a 4 in English & Maths - if not, then you retake them.


Comfort 3 - Plan of Year

The course of this year is mapped out to set your child up so they are primed to go in Year 10...

We make sure they are set up with every chance to succeed... So trust us on that...

And we usually deliver... or at least we did with 75.9% in Summer 2023....





Comfort 4 - Pathways Evening...


The Pathways Evening takes place on Thursday 7 March... and this is where your child picks their subjects for Summer 2026...

Their 'Pathway' menu will depend on where we judge their prospects.

We do not set children up to fail.

It is like a doctor diagnosing a treatment...

Or a lawyer determining a course of action...



We are making final decisions on Pathways now - and it is our decision.

Children do not leave here with nothing because we make choices that guarantee this.


